DOUGLAS COUNTY JAIL INMATE VISITATION SCHEDULE

Each Detainee is allowed a 15 minute visit.

RULES

NO MORE THAN 2 VISITORS at a time per inmate unless approved, in advance, by the Sheriff and/or Jail Administrator.

- All visitors MUST SHOW a photo ID to visit.
- No one under the age of 18 will be allowed to visit without being accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- All visitors must sign in. All visitors are subject to search by on duty officers.
 - No cell phones are allowed in the visitation area.
 - · No food or drinks are allowed in the visitation area
- All visits will be conducted by using the visitation phone system, if not used you will lose your visitation privileges

Please remember other families are visiting. If children are running or yelling, you will be asked to take them from the building.

Anyone who has been incarcerated in Douglas County Jail will not be allowed to visit until 90 DAYS after his or her release date.

All visits MUST BE arranged NO LESS THAN 24 HOURS in advance.

The only items for inmates allowed to be brought into the jail are money (cash or money order only) and paperback books (limit 2) No Magazines OR Newspapers Allowed.

Medicines (in original containers), and items prescribed by a doctor will be accepted only with written verification (prescription on bottle) from said doctor and must be approved by Jail Medical Staff before dispensing.
