NOTICE FOR VOTE BY MAIL BALLOT

ILLINOIS- Douglas County Clerk, Judi Pollock announced that all registered voters in the State of Illinois will receive by mail within the next few weeks, a notice for Vote by Mail ballot in compliance with the following statute:

(10 ILCS 5/19-2.5)

Sec. 19-2.5. Notice for vote by mail ballot. An election authority shall notify all qualified voters, except voters who have applied for permanent vote by mail status under subsection (b) of Section 19-3 or voters who submit a written request to be excluded from the permanent vote by mail status.....

This mailing will allow voters, if they choose, to request their Vote by Mail Ballot using one of the following options: 1. Single Election Vote by Mail Application, 2. Permanent Vote by Mail Status. 3. Choose to opt out of future postcard mailings.

As always voters will continue to have the option to Early Vote in the County Clerk's office or Vote on Election Day at their Polling Place.
